New Britain Emergency Medical Services has received a grant which was submitted by Schaller Auto World of New Britain for a Family Pack of CPR Mannequins from the National Automobile Dealers Charitable Foundation. Through the local leadership of Art Schaller Jr., of Schaller Auto World, this new equipment will be used by the NBEMS Community Training Center.

Teaching CPR to groups and individuals is just one way that we can meet these goals. The Community Training Center is located at NBEMS Headquarters at 225 Arch Street, New Britain. In addition to CPR Training which is given on-site as well as in schools and local area businesses, the training center also inspects and teaches parents about child safety seats and restraints, and runs classes on the use of AED's (Automatic Electric Defibrillators), and other basic First Aid and Safety Skills.
